Key words: mark making, circles, lines, movement, space, vertical, pressure, light, dark

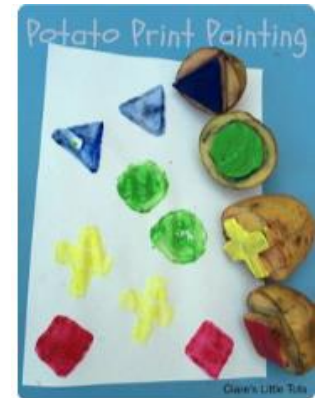
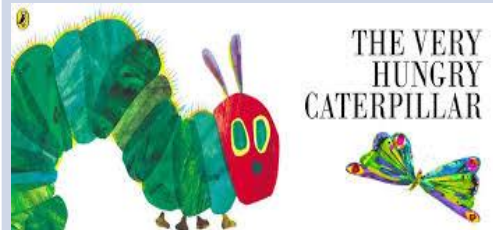
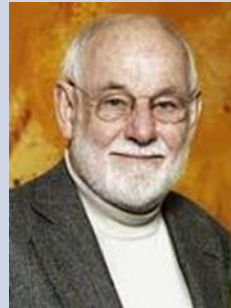

A pattern whereby it is repeated again and again and again

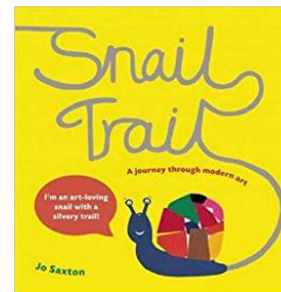
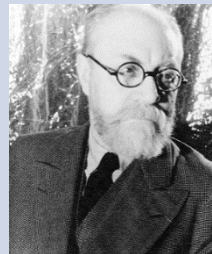

Key words: tear, layer, crumple, fold, crease, cut, fabric, pop-outs, fringe, glue, texture

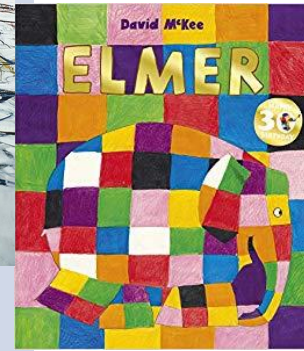
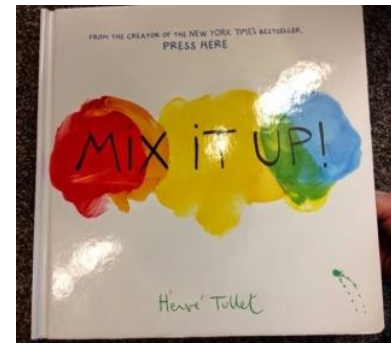
